She is winner of international prizes including the Grande Ufficiale Ordine al Merito della Repubblica Italiana in 2021, Italy's highest civilian honour, the 2020 John von Neumann Award, the 2019 All European Academies Madame de Staël Prize for Cultural Values, and 2018 Leontief Prize for Advancing the Frontiers of Economic Thought.

She is a member of the UK Academy of Social Sciences (FAcSS) and the Italian Academy of Sciences *Lincei*. In 2025, she was appointed Commander of the British Empire (CBE) for services to economics in the <u>King's Birthday Honours List</u>. Pope Francis appointed her to the Pontifical Academy for Life for bringing 'more humanity' to the world.

As well as <u>The Entrepreneurial State: debunking public vs. private</u> <u>sector myths</u> (2013), she is the author of <u>The Value of Everything:</u> <u>Making and Taking in the Global Economy</u> (2018), <u>Mission Economy</u>: <u>A Moonshot Guide to Changing Capitalism</u> (2021), and most recently <u>The Big Con: How the Consulting Industry Weakens our</u> <u>Businesses, Infantilizes our Governments and Warps our</u> <u>Economies</u> (2023).

She advises policymakers around the world on innovation-led inclusive and sustainable growth. Her roles have included for example Chair of the <u>World Health Organization's Council on the</u> <u>Economics of Health for All</u>, Co-Chair of the <u>Global Commission on</u> the Economics of Water, a member of the <u>South African President's</u> <u>Economic Advisory Council</u>, Co-Chair of the Group of Experts to the <u>G20 Task Force for the Global Mobilization against Climate Change</u>, and Special Representative of President Ramaphosa to the G20 Taskforce 1 on Inclusive Economic Growth, Industrialization, Employment, and Reduced Inequality.
